Next year will see the 90 years since the first London Gang Show in 1932. As has become a tradition we are staging a special one night Gang Show to celebrate this milestone – celebrating 90 years and looking forward to the next 90! This will be known as “GS90” and 60 shows from around the UK have indicated interest in taking part. With a cast of 200 it should be a fantastic evening.

We are delighted to announce that GS90 will take place on Saturday, 9th July 2022 at the famed Eventim Apollo, Hammersmith, London.

Yes, GS90 will indeed be ‘Live at the Apollo!’

The Eventim Apollo, formally the Hammersmith Apollo, is one of London’s major live entertainment venues. Located in Hammersmith, West London, it is one of the UK’s largest and best preserved art deco theatres. Having opened its doors in 1932, it will also be the venue’s 90th birthday in 2022, so perfectly apt for our own celebration.

To list the endless acts, performers, bands & productions that have appeared at The Apollo over its iconic history would take until GS100! But those that have also performed Live at The Apollo include the likes of Ed Sheeran, Paloma Faith, Queen, David Bowie, Robbie Williams, Elton John, Kanye West, Cliff Richards, Duke Ellington and The Beatles.... The list goes on and on.

The venue has also featured in many films and TV programs and played host to a number of stage productions including Joseph and the Amazing Technicolour Dreamcoat, Dr Doolittle, SpongeBob SquarePants, and has even hosted The Royal Variety Performance!
