




GS90 – IT’S THE FINAL COUNTDOWN!

Cast Recruitment

As set out in the last newsletter, we plan to commence cast recruitment in September. We will be producing recruitment and briefing packs over the forthcoming weeks, including what we will expect from the cast and what they can expect from us. Full details will be supplied along with the next instalment of the GS90 newsletter in early September. We will be asking each show to return names to us in mid-November so that we can have our initial meeting with all the cast on **Monday 6th December**. We really want them to help shape GS90 and we will provide opportunity for input. Please be ready to propose names.

We know and understand that many Gangs will not have met for a while and indeed may be amid cancelling their own 2021 productions. Please don't let not being in current show/rehearsal mode stop somebody from having the opportunity. Remember we are looking for cast members to be over 14 and under 25 years old on the day of the performance.

Gang Show 90 Logistics Lead

The **GS90** Logistics Lead will be responsible for a variety of projects, aiding the delivery of necessary resources and infrastructure to support the considerable production requirements of **GS90**. Performing a significant role within the **GS90** Show Management Team, responsibilities will include on-line research, location & site visits, liaison with external providers and negotiation of costs. Essential

Reporting directly to the Show Manager, The **GS90** Logistics Lead will provide recommendations on the best and most cost-effective means to deliver logistical requirements within their remit and be responsible for leading a small team in support of these responsibilities.

GS90 is to be staged at The Eventim Apollo, London on 9th July 2022, with rehearsals being held Thursday 2nd to Sunday 5th June and Friday 24th to Sunday 26th June, these are likely to be in the Midlands area. The ability to travel is an essential requirement for the role, expenses incurred in-keeping with role requirements will be reimbursed in line with the **GS90** expense policy.

The closing date for applications is Sunday 25th July 2021, with the successful candidate commencing as soon as possible to support on-going logistical requirements.

Roles and Responsibilities will include.

- Research and implementation of
 - Rehearsal venue(s)
 - Cast accommodation
 - Cast transportation (Production requirements, not personal transport requirements).
- Provide logistical support to overcome identified obstacles, for example cast changing facilities.
- Lead and coordinate others in delivery of identified logistical requirements.
- Work closely with Catering & Welfare Leads to deliver necessary outcomes.
- Support the Show Manager in the overall delivery of **GS90** production requirements.

Essential Criteria

- Own transportation
- Experience with 'Gang Show' production and entwined logistics
- Knowledge and understanding of Scouts Safeguarding and Safety policies

Desirable Criteria

- Knowledge and understanding of Child Performance Regulations
- Experience of leading teams in the delivery of projects
- Experience in the completion of risk assessments
